This Agreement is entered into by and between SSC Raymondville Operating Company LLC d/b/a Retama Manor Nursing Center/Raymondville and Raymondville ISD – CNA Program.

It is mutually agreed that the purpose of this Agreement is to guide a working relationship between Retama Manor Nursing Center/Raymondville hereinafter referred to as "Clinical Site" and Raymondville ISD – CNA Program hereinafter as "School", to provide C.N.A. experiential training for Certified Nurse Aide students to become effective as the 11th day of February, 2020.

1. The school will:

- a) Provide assistance in the development of the students' learning experience that is in keeping with the school's objectives for clinical education and compatible with the type of service the Clinical Site offers.
- b) Assign a faculty representative from the school to serve as liaison between the school and the Clinical site.
- c) Share with the Clinical Site the information about a students' background, education, and interests, provided such information is exchanged in compliance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974, as amended.
- d) Be available for emergency situations involving students.
- e) Assure student observance of policies and procedures of the Clinical Site.
- f) Assure compliance with Clinical Site's recommended health screening tests (PPD) and vaccinations (MMR and Hepatitis B) for health professional students. Each student will receive OSHA training for Blood borne Pathogens and Universal Precautions and HIPPA training on the privacy of patient identifiable information, immunization records available upon request.
- g) School will conduct criminal background checks to national sex offender registry and to state abuse monthly OIG exclusion list.
- h) Monitor students' course path and progress in the program
- i) Provide transportation to and from the facility

2. The Clinical Site will:

a) Provide clinical facilities for school students in accordance with agreement by the faculty of the school and designated Clinical Site staff.

- b) Retain full responsibility for the care of patients and maintain the quality of care without relying on student's clinical training activities for staffing purposes. Any service rendered by students is incidental to the educational purpose of the practice experience program.
- c) Assign a staff representative as liaison between the Clinical Site and the school to orient students and to assist in scheduling
- d) Make provision for orientation of students to the Clinical Site and permit use of space necessary for the students to perform their activities.
- e) Provide a qualified RN or LVN preceptor who will provide immediate supervision of NA students. "Immediate supervision" means that a Registered Nurse or Licensed Vocational Nurse shall at all times be physically present with the NA students in accordance with state guidelines.
- f) Retain the right to immediately return and dismiss from the Clinical Site any student whose behavior is such that it interferes with proper patient care or services or the smooth operation of the facility. Consultation between Clinical Site and school shall precede any such action.
- g) Coordinate with school personnel to interview students for any jobs for which the student is qualified that are available on the student's completion of the program
- h) Provide work-based learning experiences for students appropriate to each grade level, such as facility visits, guest speakers, presentations, career information, job shadowing, internships, externships, apprenticeships, and career mentoring
- i) Support student activities such as clubs, Career and Technical Student Organizations, competitions and special initiatives
- 3. Representatives of the school and Clinical Site will meet at least annually to jointly review the use of the Clinical Site facilities.
- 4. The school shall not discriminate in the assignment of students to this Clinical Site based on sex, race, color, creed, national origin, age, veteran's status or handicap where otherwise qualified.
- 5. The Clinical Site assumes no liability for any injury, which may occur to students participating in the Program

This agreement will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas. The terms of this agreement shall be automatically renewed unless either party to the agreement shall notify the other in writing of its intention not to renew. This agreement may be terminated by either party for any reason with 90 days written notice given to the other party.
