

AECHS Admission Policy

Achieve Early College High School's primary focus is on providing students from underrepresented backgrounds (i.e. at-risk, low income and/or first generation college attendees) the opportunity to earn 60+ college credits free of charge while attending high school. As a designated Early College High School we must target students from underrepresented backgrounds; however, we encourage students of all backgrounds to apply.

Achieve Early College High School is available to any 8th grade students or any High School students attending other Early College setting that meets the criteria listed below:

- 1. The student must have a desire to be a part of the AECHS program and be able to explain this in a writing.
- 2. The student's parent and/or guardian must want their child to be part of the program.
- 3. Both the parent/guardian must agree to abide by the standards of academic and behavioral expectations of AECHS.
- 4. Both the parent and student must agree to comply with all the policies of the program including the Electronic Information resource agreement for issued devices.
- 5. Both parent and student must agree that the ultimate goal is to graduate from AECHS with college credits as planned.

Note: In accordance with the Texas Education Agency rules for AECHS Blueprint Benchmark 1, academics, discipline, state assessments and/or teacher recommendations cannot be considered in the selection process.
