Dr. Emilio Castro – Superintendent – The Superintendent will collaborate with the district’s Business Manager, High School Principal and ECHS Dean regarding implementation of the ECHS model. This role oversees the financial sustainability of the program in its entirety.

Kelli DuBose – Director of Curriculum and Instruction – Director of Curriculum and Instruction collaborates with Dean of ECHS, school Principal, and Counselor to ensure the fidelity within the program. This role develops systems that support pre-Ap, AP, and dual credit, including pathways.

Mark Tribett- Dilley High School Principal – The High School Principal oversees the daily operations of the ECHS program. He serves as the primary administrator of the ECHS program and collaborates with the Dean of ECHS in development and guidance of the master schedule, implementing policies, curriculum activities, ECHS processes such as recruitment, data collecting, and provides professional development and budget in a manner that promotes the educational development of staff and students within the Early College High School program.

Adriann Ramirez – Dean of Early College High School – The Dean of ECHS is responsible for implementing strategies to ensure participation, provide admission support and administrative support to staff and students. The Dean also establishes relationships with all stakeholders and collaborates with them to establish a structure and productive program for the students of ECHS. The biggest role is to recruit, retain and increase dual credit enrollment.

Bonnie Hale – Dilley High School Counselor – has the responsibility of academic advising to assist students in developing meaningful educational plans that meet the requirements of high school graduation and pathway that lead to an Associates Degree. The Counselor collaborates with the Dean of Early College High school to ensure that

the students are assessed and enrolled in the ECHS program upon meeting all qualifying credentials for Early College. She serves as the High School academic advisor and facilitates transition to college, preparation for postsecondary readiness exams, and guides students on their educational pathway to earning an Associates Degree. The Counselor also plays a critical role in recruitment, retention, and advising for all students of DISD and DISD -Early College High School.

Rally Ochoa – Dilley High School CTE/CCMR Coordinator – The CTE/CCMR Coordinator collaborates with all stakeholders to develop, facilitate, and coordinate secondary Career and Technical Education programs to support career clusters, pathways and programs of study with the integration of academics.

Cruz Mata – SWTJC Student Advisor – responsible for providing educational guidance and assistance for students by planning schedules, recommending courses and determining appropriate education solutions for different types of students.
