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## AGENDA DETAILS

### I. ECHS OUTCOMES-BASED MEASURES (OBMS)

- a. Tasks that need to be completed before the upcoming PEIMS snapshot on Friday, October 27, 2023:
  - i. Verify Cohort List of Students (All Counselors)
  - ii. Verify At-Risk Eligibility (All Counselors)
- b. Specific grade-level responsibilities
  - i. **9th Grade Counselor:** Verify the list of cohort students and ensure they'll complete at least 6 college credits by the end of 9th grade (refer to BISD DE crosswalk).
  - ii. **10th Grade Counselor:** AT least 40% of the 10th-grade cohort students have scheduled enough DE courses to complete 9 college credits (any) by the end of 10th grade (refer to old blueprint page 17). Adjust the students schedules for the spring semester if needed so they can register for the DE courses they require.
  - iii. **11th Grade Counselor:** At least 60% of the cohort students must have passed the TSI Math OR met the TSI exemption through the successful completion of the first college math course (e.g., MATH 1314 or higher) by the end of 11th grade (refer to old blueprint page 18). At least 70% of the cohort students must have passed the TSI ELAR OR TSI exemption through the successful completion of the first college reading/writing course (e.g., ENGL 1301/1302) by the end of 11th grade (refer to old blueprint page 18).
  - iv. **12th Grade Counselor:** At least 65% of the cohort students must have completed at least 15 college credits (any) by graduation. At least 30% of the cohort students must have completed the Texas Core Curriculum (Core 42) by graduation. At least 40% of the cohort students must have earned an associate degree by graduation. At least 45% of the cohort students must enroll in a 2-year or 4-year institution.

### II. ECHS COHORT TRACKING SHEETS

- a. All grade-level counselors will use this document and update it on a regular basis to track both the DE courses completed by the cohort students and the OBM indicators.

### III. TSC SPRING DE REGISTRATION

- a. All grade-level counselors will continue to use the TSC Master List to track Dual Enrollment and Cohort students taking DE courses.
- b. New and returning students who wish to take Dual Enrollment classes in the spring semester must submit all requirements and DE Packets to their grade-level counselor by Monday, November 13, 2023.
- c. Grade-level counselors will review the Spring semester schedules to ensure that all students are scheduled for their next Dual Enrollment course following the BISD Course Listing Guide crosswalk for dual enrollment courses.
