Procedures for Texas Success Initiative Assessment 2.0 (TSIA 2.0) Testing

All students that are part of the South San West Campus Early College Academy and are in the 9th grade or above have challenged the TSIA 2.0 at least 2 times. Should students not be successful in achieving a “College Ready” status, these are the procedures for assisting the student to be successful in the TSIA 2.0 exam.

Step 1: The student must register in [Shmoop](#) and join their respective class cohort.

Step 2: The student must challenge the diagnostic exam in Shmoop for the subject area in which they have not achieved a “College Ready” status.

Step 3: After challenging the necessary diagnostic exam*, the student will tutor within the Shmoop online platform under the “study” tab, for the subject area needing remediation for at least 20 minutes daily throughout the month, so that they may be prepared to challenge the real TSIA 2.0 on the last Friday of each month.

Step 4: It is crucial that the student register to challenge the TSIA 2.0 exam through the Google Form: Request for TSIA 2.0 Testing before the 2nd to last Friday of each month. (The student must demonstrate tutoring time on Shmoop in order to be allowed to challenge the real exam.)

Tutoring availability:

All tutoring is an online platform and can be done through Shmoop under the study tab. Students may participate in a monitored session on online tutoring with a teacher afterschool or can elect to do it independently on their own time so that they may be allowed to challenge the real TSIA 2.0.

All Freshmen SS ECA students have the capability of doing online tutoring through their Freshman transition course as well.

*The diagnostic exam is designed to mirror the real TSIA 2.0. After a student challenges the diagnostic test they are tutored in the program in the “study” tab from the results of their diagnostic test. The tutoring focuses on building up the weaknesses detected from the diagnostic test. It is crucial that students take the diagnostic test with much importance.
